

## SUPPLIES

- 24" Bowdabra® bow tie or 1/4"W satin ribbon
- 6-1/2' of 6" wide tulle
- 3 14" Lengths of floral strings (or adjust length to your personal taste.)
- 2 36" Lengths of Bowdabra® bow tie or 1/4"W satin ribbon



## PUTTING IT TOGETHER...



1. Fold the 24" Bowdabra® bow tie or satin ribbon in half and lay it into the Bowdabra®.



2. Make a Scrunchy Bow using the 6-1/2' piece of tulle to create a 6" wide bow. (Detailed, step-by-step instructions are included in the Bowdabra® Basic Techniques booklet.)



3. Lay the 3 floral strings into the Bowdabra® on top of the Scrunchy Bow. The should be fanned at angles to each other.

## FLOWERGIRL BOUQUET BALL - continued







- 4. Gently loop a 36" length of bow tie or satin ribbon twice, so that you have a 3 12" long layers. Lay the bow tie into the Bowdabra®. Scrunch everything down with the Bowdabra® wand.
- 5. Repeat step 4 with the second 36" length of bow tie.
- 6. Grasp the loose ends of the first piece of 24" bow tie (first layer in the Bowabra®) and feed them through the loop. Pull the bow tie tight while still in the Bowdabra®. Take the ball out of the Bowdabra®. Separate the 2 loose ends of the bow tie and bring them around to the back of the ball. Tie a tight knot to secure.
- 7. Do a final fluffing and shaping.

8. Tie a knot at the end of the 2 loose end of satin ribbon or Bowdabra® bow tie where the flowergirl will carry the Flowergirl Bouquet Ball.
